<b>GPA Weightings:</b>	Melbourne and UWA rank using weighted GPA based on last 3 years of study; the rest use cumulative GPA
<b>DAT:</b>	Chart represents the AA of a DAT, though each university may rank with a slightly different calculation. Some universities consider the PAT. None use the MDT. DAT not used for UG.
<b>Admissions Style:</b>	All programs use pooled assessments.
<b>Int'l Seats:</b>	These are the seats allocated to off-shore and on-shore international students; these can vary each year.
<b>Best Indicators of Success:</b>	Competitive and average scores, not minimums
