DAT: Chart represents the AA of a DAT, though each university may rank with a slightly different calculation. Some universities consider the PAT. None use the MDT. *OzTREKK minimum to submit based on competitive scores from previous intakes.

Admissions Style: All programs use pooled assessments.

Int'l Seats: Seats allocated to international students; vary by year and should be considered estimates.

Best Indicators of Success: Competitive and average scores, not minimums.
