The Australian Government has replaced the Genuine Temporary Entrant (GTE) requirement for student visas with a Genuine Student (GS) requirement (Ministerial Direction 106). This is effective for student visa applications lodged on and after 23 March 2024.

Introduction

What is the Genuine Student requirement?

All applicants for a student visa must be a genuine applicant for entry. They must stay as a student and be able to show an understanding that studying in Australia is the primary reason of their student visa. The GS requirement is intended to include students who, after studying in Australia, develop skills Australia needs and who then go on to apply for permanent residence.

To be granted a student visa, all applicants must demonstrate they satisfy the genuine student criterion or the genuine student dependent criterion.

Student visa applicants will be expected to answer the below questions as a part of the visa application. The word limit is 150 words per question. For more information please see:

Genuine Student requirement

As a part of the assessment of your application for admission to Charles Sturt University, we require the following questions to be answered, answers should be 150 words per question.

- 1. Explain why you wish to study this course in Australia with Charles Sturt University. This must also explain your understanding of the requirements of the intended course and studying and living in Australia. Your statement must include the following:**
 - Demonstrate your understanding of the intended course, what you expect to learn and what aspects of the course interest you the most.

- 2. Brief description of the campus and awareness of the location. Your statement must include the following:**
 - What provider options did you compare in Australia and reasons for choosing Charles Sturt University Orange campus specifically.
