3 Work while you study

A student visa allows students to work up to 48 hours per fortnight. Depending on the type of student visa you hold, you may be eligible to work part-time during study periods and full-time during official breaks. Students have access to a wide range of opportunities, including casual, part-time, and full-time jobs, as well as internships and industry placements across growing sectors such as healthcare, education, hospitality, construction, and technology.

4 Return on investment

Studying on the Gold Coast offers great value, combining quality education, work experience, and clear visa pathways. Students gain in-demand skills and local experience that support migration opportunities, including employer sponsorship and permanent residency. With strong industry ties and a growing job market, it's a smart choice for long-term success in Australia.

5 Post-Higher Education Work Visa

International students who complete eligible courses on the Gold Coast and meet the required criteria may qualify for a post-study work visa, whether from higher education or vocational education pathways. This allows them to stay and work in Australia for 18 months to 4 years, depending on their level of qualification.

6 Scholarships and student grants

The Gold Coast provides strong support for international students through a variety of scholarships and grants.

Local universities, TAFE Queensland, and private institutions regularly offer scholarships based on academic merit, diversity, and multicultural engagement.

Sweet TRANSPORT

Getting around the Gold Coast as a student is easy thanks to the city's integrated public transport network, which includes buses, trams, and trains that connect major suburbs, campuses, and attractions.

All public transport fares in Queensland cost 50c meaning its a very cheap mode of travel for students.

The G:link light rail (tram) runs from Helensvale to Broadbeach and passes through key locations like Surfers Paradise, offering a reliable way to travel along the coast. Cycling is also popular on the Gold Coast and made easier by the city's flat landscape and great climate.

The Gold Coast is serviced by two major airports.

Brisbane Airport is about an hour's drive north of Surfers Paradise, and the Gold Coast Airport is conveniently located 40 minutes south of Surfers Paradise. Both airports offer domestic and international services.
